VYNDAMAX is a prescription medicine used to treat adults with the cardiomyopathy of wild-type or hereditary transthyretin-mediated amyloidosis (ATTR-CM) to reduce death and hospitalization related to heart problems. It is not known if VYNDAMAX is safe and effective in children.

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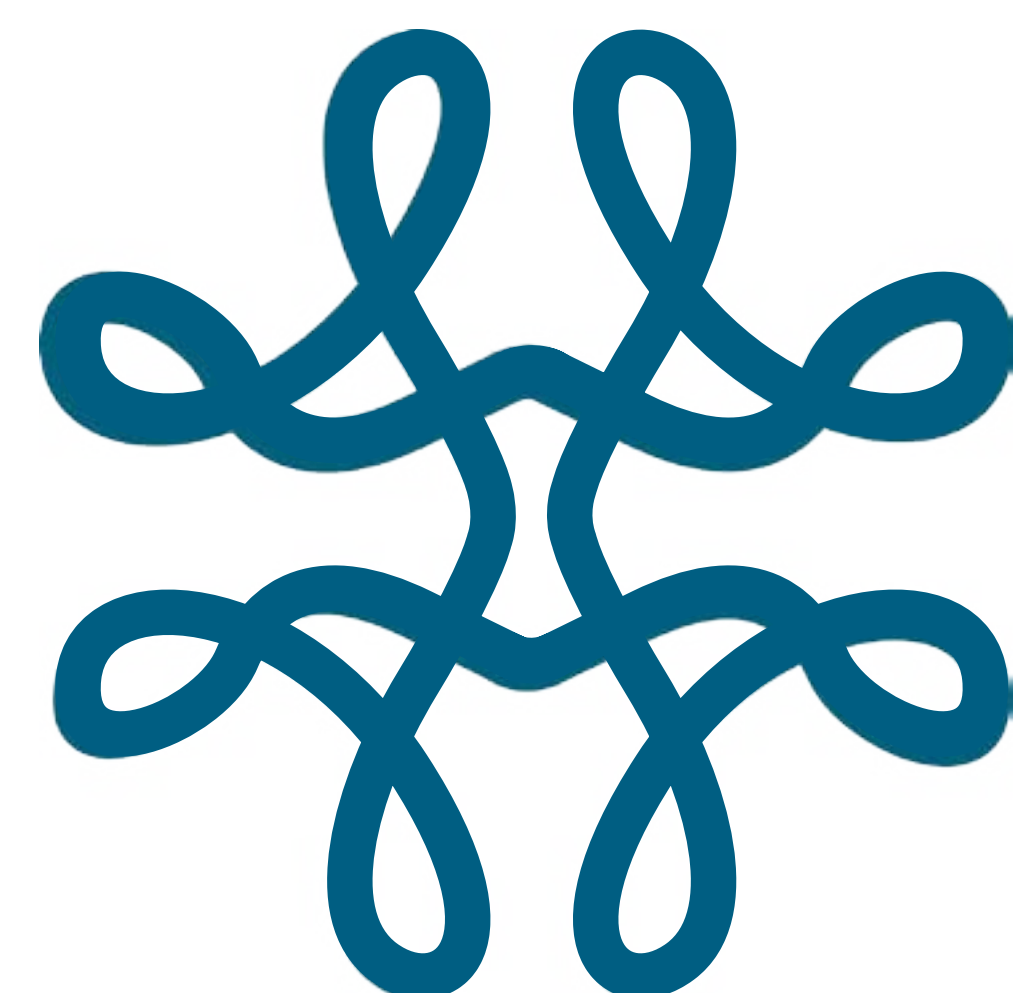


## Understanding your ATTR-CM diagnosis

ATTR-CM is a rare, serious, underrecognized, and underdiagnosed type of amyloidosis that affects your heart. It's important to understand that ATTR-CM is a **life-threatening, progressive condition**, which means it will get worse over time.

Amyloidosis is a group of diseases in which certain proteins change shape, or misfold, and can then build up in different parts of the body. When these misfolded proteins build up in your heart, it may lead to ATTR-CM.

### How does ATTR-CM affect your heart?

Your liver produces transthyretin (**TTR**), a transport protein that carries the hormone thyroxine and vitamin A (retinol) throughout the bloodstream.



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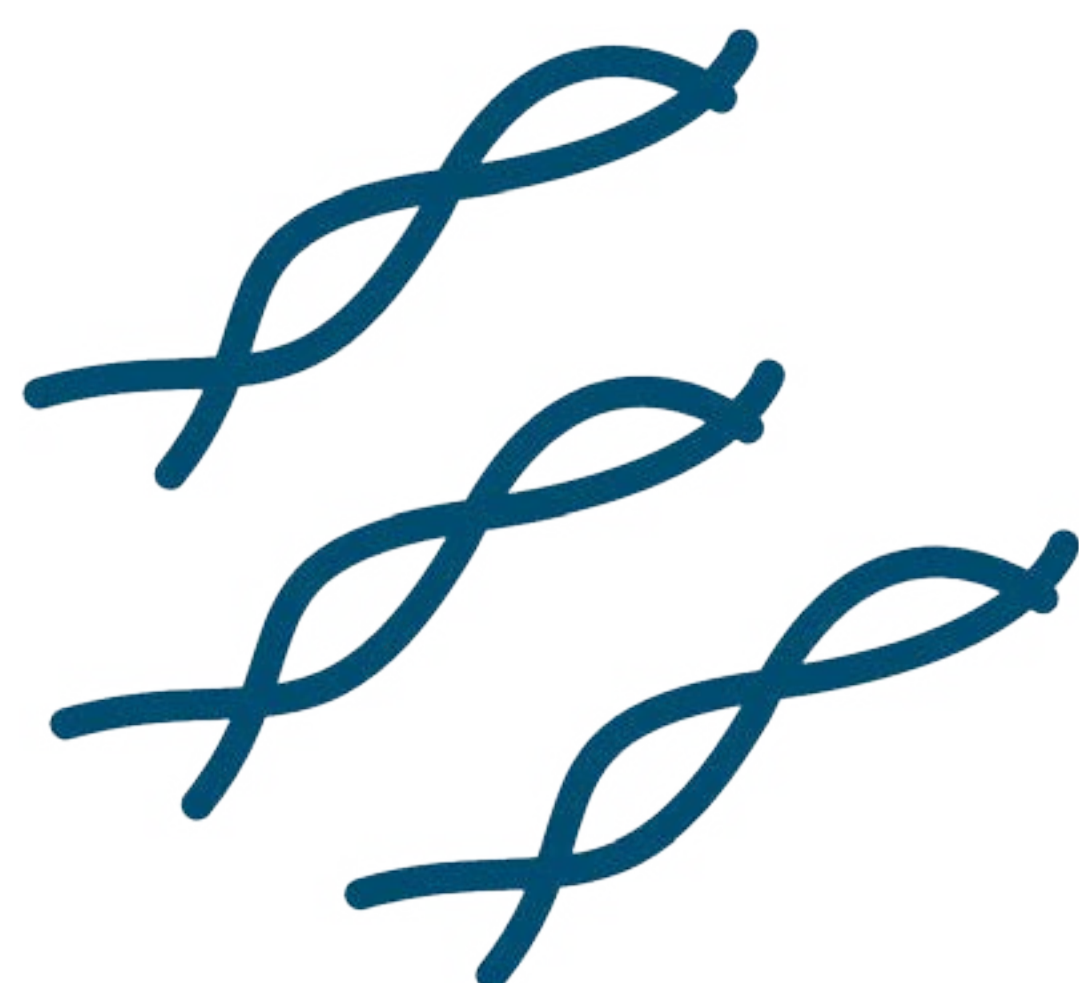


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### How does ATTR-CM affect your heart?

When you have ATTR-CM, either due to aging (**wild-type**) or an inherited genetic variant (**hereditary**), the protein becomes unstable and **misfolds**.



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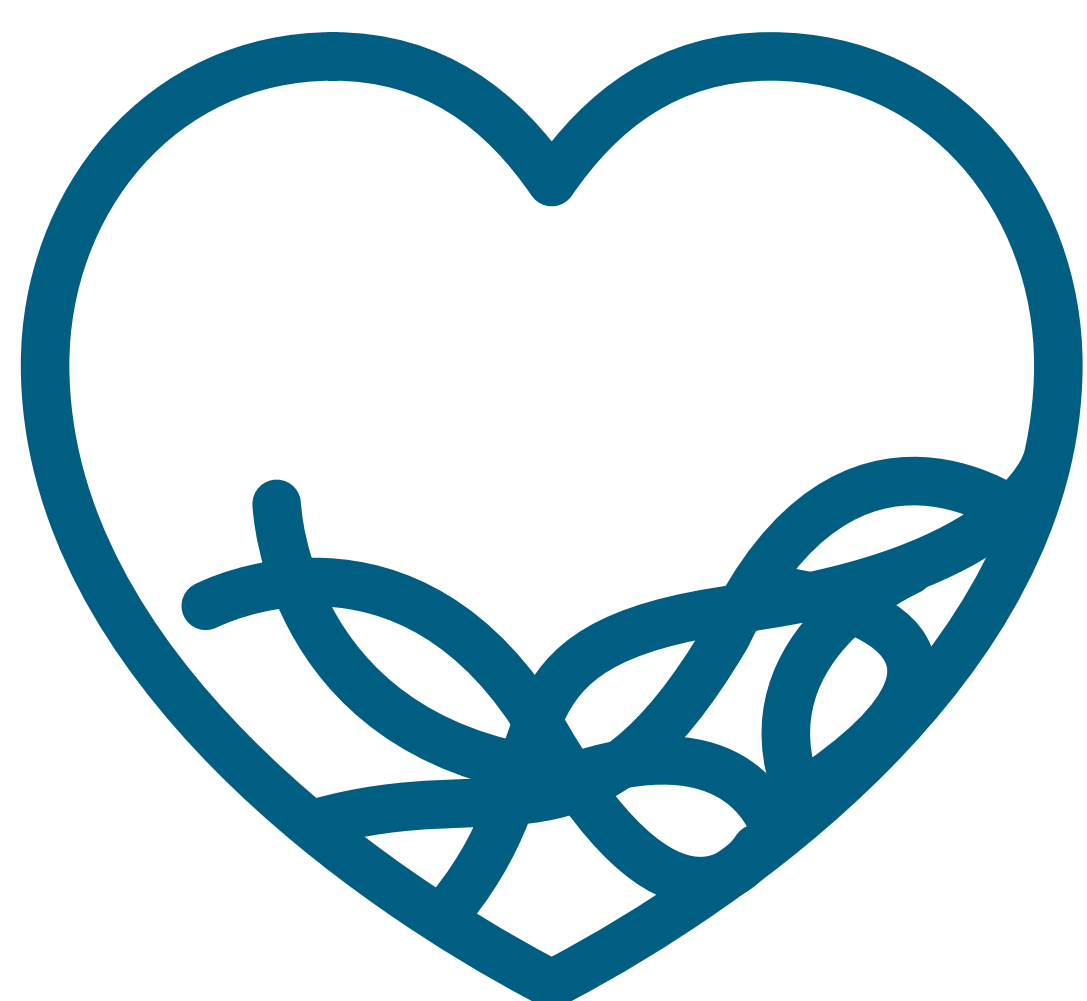


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### How does ATTR-CM affect your heart?

Over time, the misfolded proteins **build up in the heart**, causing the muscles to thicken and stiffen, eventually leading to heart failure.



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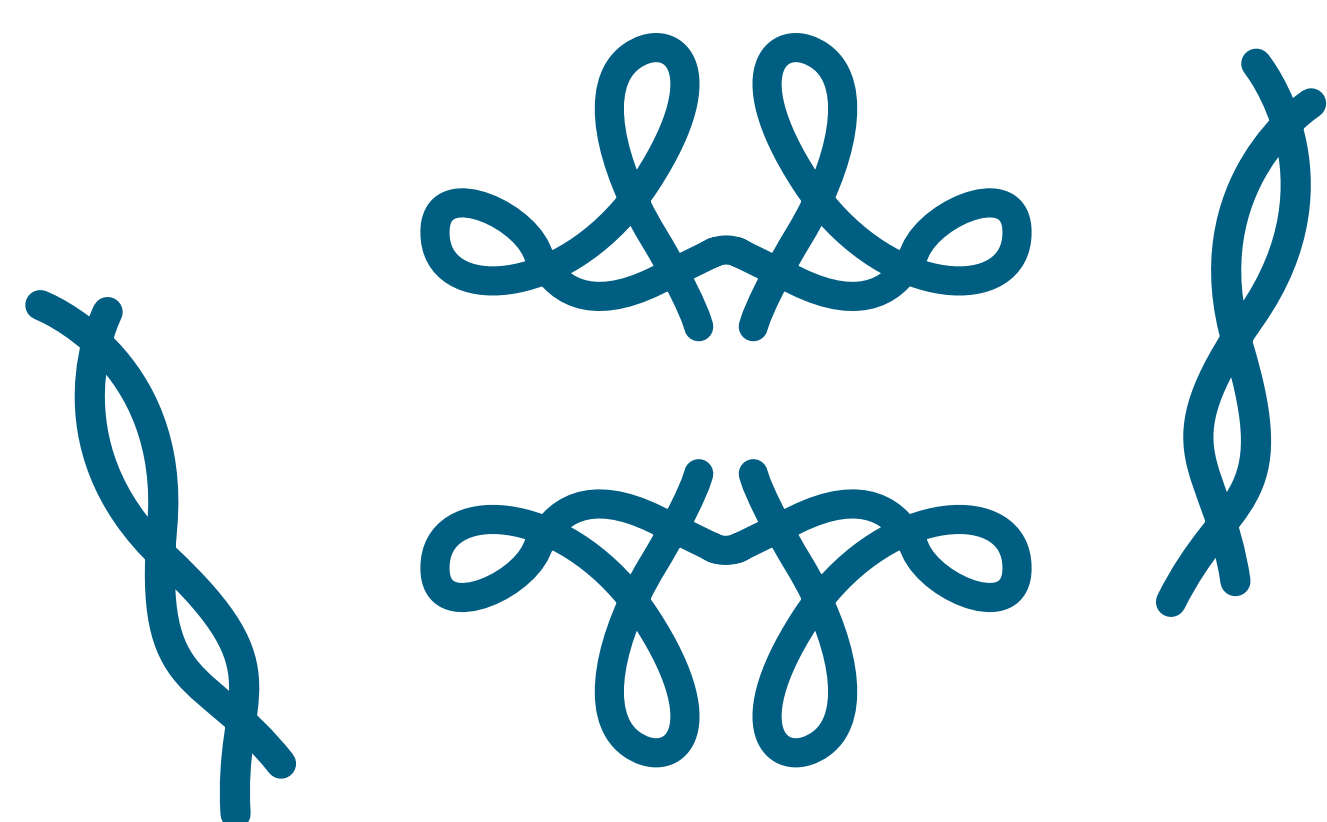




## What is VYNDAMAX?

VYNDAMAX is a once-daily, single-capsule treatment for ATTR-CM.

### Here's how VYNDAMAX works inside your body:

**TTR becomes unstable** and breaks into misfolded pieces, which can build up in the heart and lead to ATTR-CM.



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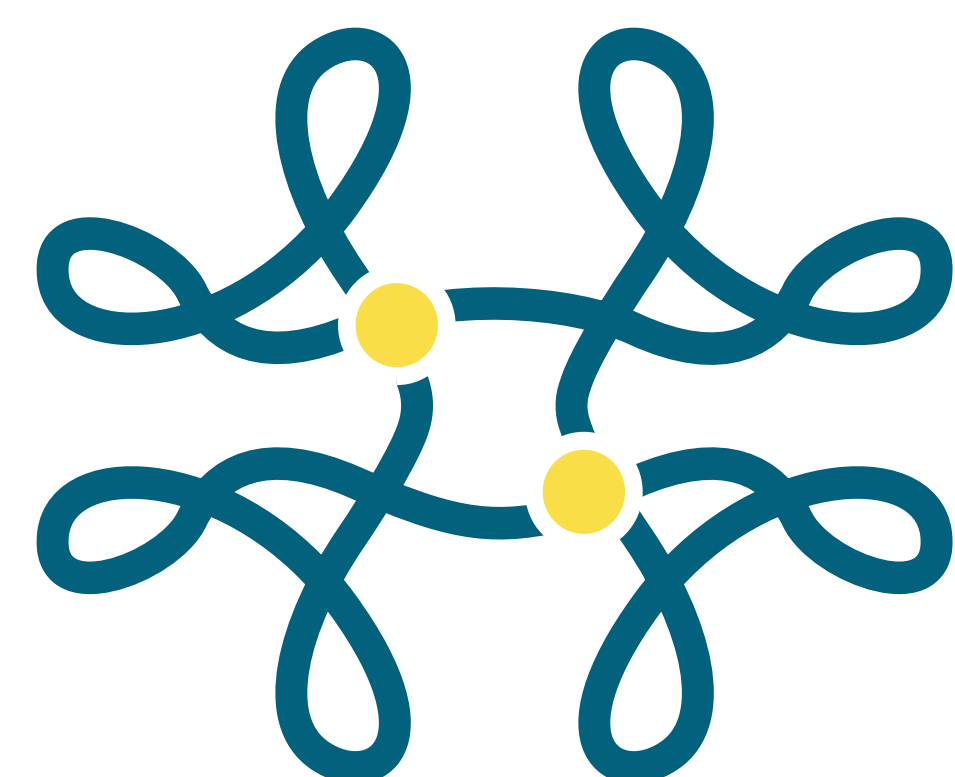

**VYNDAMAX binds** to weakening TTR and stabilizes it, so it stays together longer.



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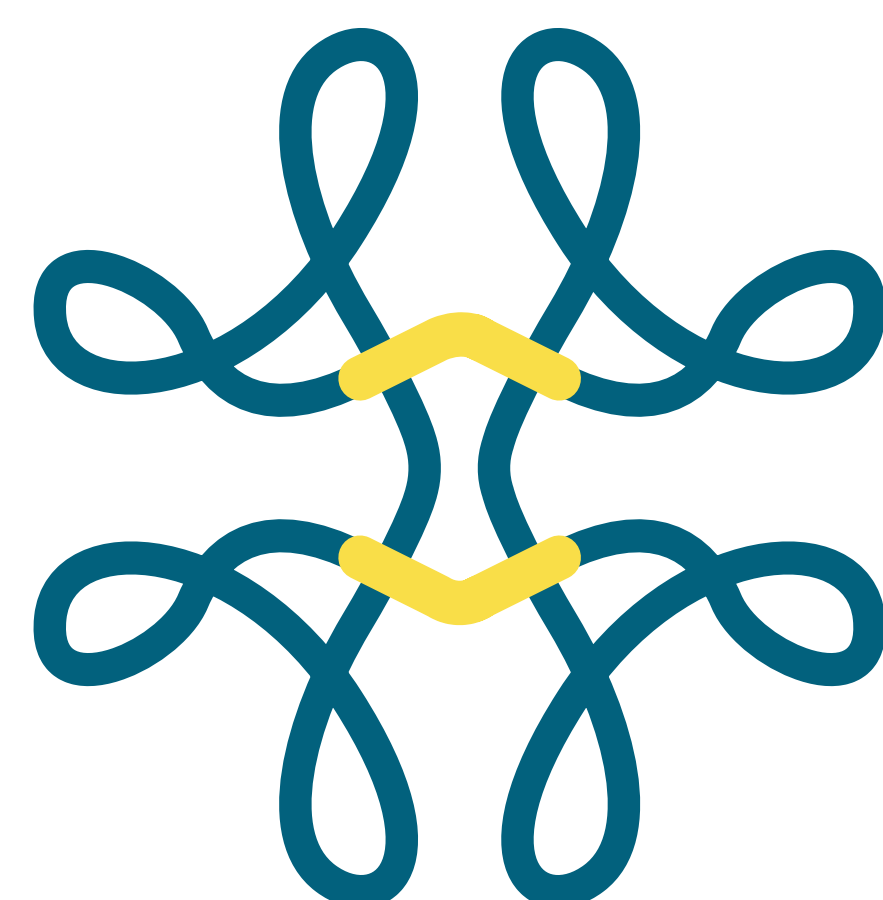




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### Here's how VYNDAMAX works inside your body:

**By slowing the breakdown of TTR,**  
VYNDAMAX slows the formation and  
buildup of misfolded pieces in the heart.



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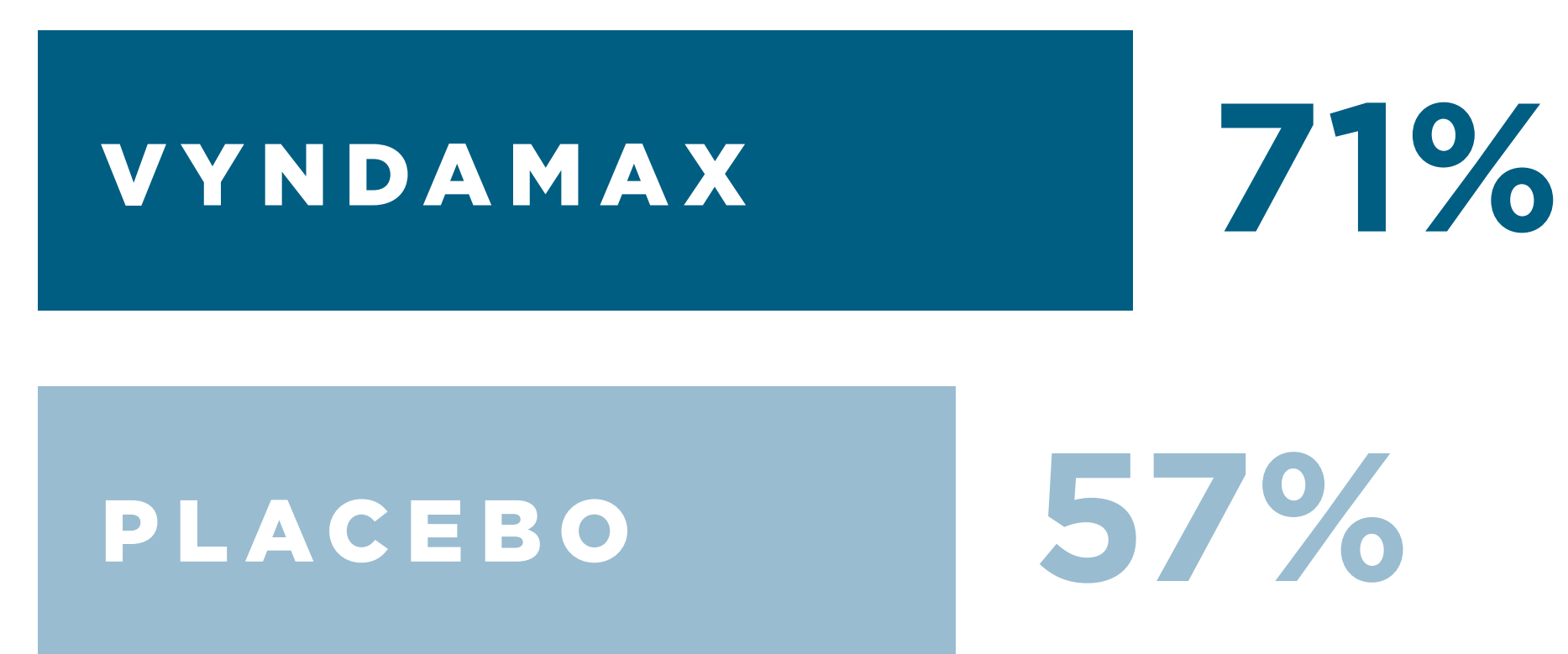
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## How can VYNDAMAX help me?

In a clinical trial, VYNDAMAX was proven to significantly reduce death and the number of heart-related hospitalizations in patients with ATTR-CM. Patients in the VYNDAMAX group lived longer than those in the placebo group.

People taking VYNDAMAX also saw a slower decline in quality-of-life measures, including physical abilities and social activities, compared with those on placebo. Results were noticed in as little as 6 months, and remained consistent throughout the 30-month trial.

The clinical studies of VYNDAQEL® (tafamidis meglumine) supported the approval of VYNDAMAX, which contains the same active ingredient.

**VYNDAMAX works to help slow the progression of the disease, so you may not feel an effect on your symptoms. It's very important to continue taking VYNDAMAX, as prescribed, to help increase your chances of staying out of the hospital and living longer.**

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## How do I take VYNDAMAX?

The first and only once-daily, single-capsule treatment for ATTR-CM



VYNDAMAX offers convenient dosing.

- A single 61-mg, once-daily capsule
- Taken by mouth

It is important to continue taking it as prescribed by your doctor.

- VYNDAMAX capsules should be swallowed whole and never crushed or cut
- If you miss a dose, take it as soon as you remember
- If it is time for your next dose, skip the missed dose and take the next dose at your regularly scheduled time
- Do not take 2 doses at the same time

**There were no known side effects that happened during treatment with VYNDAMAX. No additional lab testing or monitoring is required with VYNDAMAX.**

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## How do I get started on VYNDAMAX® (tafamidis)?

### 1 Doctor prescribes VYNDAMAX

- Your doctor sends your VYNDAMAX\* prescription to a specialty pharmacy, which will ship specialty medications to a patient's home



**Watch out for a call from the specialty pharmacy.**

### 2 Confirm insurance coverage

- The specialty pharmacy will contact your insurance plan to confirm your coverage for VYNDAMAX, including co-payment amounts and other financial assistance options
- The specialty pharmacy will review coverage with you by phone and can also discuss financial assistance options

### 3 Receive VYNDAMAX

- Once your insurance is approved, the specialty pharmacy will work with you to coordinate the delivery of VYNDAMAX

### 4 Continuing VYNDAMAX

- Your doctor will tell you what clinical and insurance requirements are needed to continue on VYNDAMAX
- The specialty pharmacy will coordinate with you and your doctor to make sure your information is up to date

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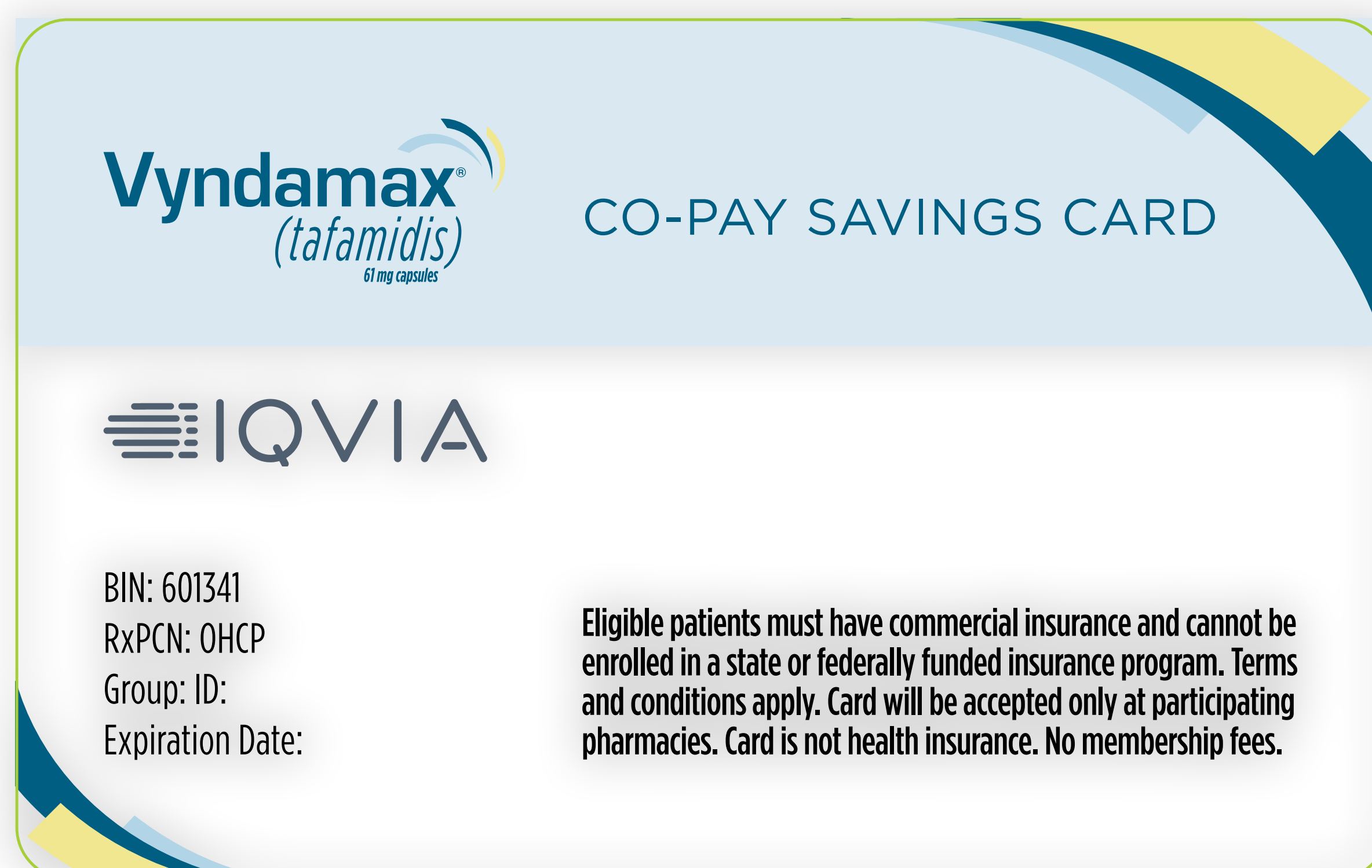
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## What financial assistance options are available?
