# A quick guide for patients taking VYNDAMAX

In 2025: \$2000 is the out-of-pocket (OOP) cap for covered Medicare Part D medicines. Once you reach the OOP cap, you will pay **\$0** for all covered medicines for the rest of the year.<sup>1</sup>

There will now be 3 phases of Medicare Part D coverage: deductible, initial coverage, and catastrophic coverage.<sup>1</sup> During each phase, you will pay your health plan's premium each month. The amount you pay for your medicines depends on which phase of Medicare Part D you are in.<sup>1-3</sup> These phases apply to **all** your medicines that are covered by Medicare Part D.<sup>1</sup>

## New in 2025: Medicare Prescription Payment Plan<sup>2\*</sup>

The Medicare Prescription Payment Plan is a new program for Medicare Part D. The health plan must give patients who enroll the choice to pay for their medicines in monthly installments.<sup>+</sup>

You can spread the costs of your prescription medicines over 1 calendar year



The program is voluntary. You can enroll during open enrollment or anytime in the plan year



When enrolled, you pay \$0 at the pharmacy



Your health plan sends you monthly bills for cost-sharing

\*There is no fee to join the plan. This plan does not cover a patient's monthly premium.<sup>2,3</sup> \*You need to opt in to the payment plan before filling your prescription.<sup>2,3</sup>

## Find the right health plan during open enrollment, October 15 to December 7<sup>4</sup>

Open enrollment is a time of year when you can make changes to your Medicare health plan to make sure you have the right coverage for your needs.<sup>4</sup> During open enrollment, check your medicines' coverage.
